



Pickleball rules

Players:

- 1- Each team will have 2 players with one substitute as needed.
- 2- Each team is ranked by levels- 4.0 (top), 3.5, 3.0 and 2.5 (Lowest)
- 3- If a team has not ranked themselves properly, the league director may move a team between levels. League director's decision is final.

Scoring:

- 1- Only the serving team can score a point.
- 2- After a serve, the ball must bounce on each side before a point can be scored.
- 3- The ball is considered in play if it hits the line. On a serve, if the ball hits the 7ft non-volley line it is a fault.
- 4- Each game is played to 15 points. First team to 15 wins.
- 5- When a team reaches 8 points, players are to switch sides.
- 6- Report scores to the front desk- name of team, points for each team.
- 7- Players are responsible for calling balls in or out. If there is a dispute, the teams will flip a coin to determine who wins the call

Service:

- 1- The first team listed, (Visitor team) is the team that serves first.

Championship Tournament

The championship tournament is a double elimination tournament with a guarantee of 4 games. The substitution rule above remains for the tournament also. That is only one player may be substituted.

Sportsmanship:

In all games, players are to treat everyone with dignity and respect. We have to remember we are not playing to win a grand prize of a million dollars or to embarrass a team by beating them 15-0. We are here to make friends, have fun, stay healthy and be competitive. Please no swearing, use of alcohol or drugs or throwing of paddles. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and you may have to forfeit games or be removed from the league.
